AN ACT TO COMBAT ORGANIZED CRIME IN RELATION TO LIBERTY AND JUSTICE

ALL CAPS

Section A. Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Missouri Boys State, as follows:

Section 1. the following statute will be added to Title II, Chapter 204:

204.60 No citizen shall – by means of bribery, extortion or other nefarious activities – participate in the creation of or activities within a criminal organization with the intent of perpetrating illegal actions in violation of the laws and statutes of Boys State.

Section 2. Any elected official of the state in violation of statute 204.60 shall be liable to impeachment under Article IV, section 21 at the Missouri Boys State Constitution.

Section 3. Any citizen accused of violation of statute 204.60 shall be given a trial where in that citizen may be charged and subsequently punished with imprisonment not to exceed a day and with a fine not to exceed \$750.

Section 4. All laws in conflict with this bill are hereby declared null and void.

Section B. This bill shall take full force and effect upon the signing of the Governor of Missouri Boys State
