AN ACT

To Revoke the Right to Vote of Third Strike State Convicts

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Missouri Boys State, as follows:

Section 1. The bill would serve to retract the right to vote from any Missouri Boys State citizen who is convicted of breaking the state law three times. The bill would ensure that those who refuse to obey the social contract would not continue to reap the benefits of the government system they refuse to follow.
