AN ACT

TO CONSERVE ENERGY RELATING TO WASTED ELECTRICITY

Section A. Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Missouri Boys State, as follows:

Section 1. As part of the daily room inspection, rooms will be checked to ensure energy conservation. To pass inspection with a grade of one, all lights in the room and adjacent bathroom must be turned off, and all devices, appliances, and cords must be unplugged from outlets. Devices and appliances are defined as any gadget that draws electricity from a wall outlet. The refrigerator of the beverage commissioner of each city is not required to be unplugged. Charging cables must be unplugged as well, even if no device is plugged into them. Appliances must be unplugged even if they are turned off.

Section B. This bill shall take full force and effect upon the signing of the Governor of Missouri Boys State
