AN ACT

TO ADD AN OFFICIAL LIGHTS OUT POLICY TO TITLE 1 OF MBS STATUTES.

Section A. Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Missouri Boys State, as follows:

Section 1. Under Missouri Boys State Statutes, Title I: General Boys State Policy, Statute 116 will be added to institute an official "Lights Out" policy.

Section 2. After the final city meeting of the day, citizens are to be given 30 minutes free time before mandatory lights out as a minimum with additional time added by way of a $\frac{2}{3} + 1$ majority.

Section 3. This time will be used for general citizen recreation inside city walls, insofar that the recreation does not break any city, state, county or counselor rules.

Section 4. A \$50 dollar fine will be charged to any citizens not adhering to lights out. This fine will go directly and fully to the city the fine was charged in.

Section B. This bill shall take full force and effect upon the signing of the Governor of Missouri Boys State
