AN ACT

Privacy

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Missouri Boys State, as follows:

Section 1. Any person in any position, including and especially those in the fire department, police and public safety administration, are not allowed to violate the privacy of their fellow citizens and enter into the room of another citizen, without a court order

Section 2. All inspections of rooms by fire department and public safety officials shall be done looking in from the threshold, or in the presence of one or more residents of that room, so as to not present the opportunity for theft and invasion of privacy

Section 3. The punishment for any citizen entering into a room not belonging to them shall be a 100 dollar fine, paid immediately to the city in which the crime was committed
