AN ACT

REGULATION FROM THE EXECUTIVE IN NEED OF SCRUTINY ACT

Section A. Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Missouri Boys State, as follows:

Section 1. Regulation from the Executive in need of Scrutiny Act.

Section 2. State that the purpose of this act is to increase accountability for and transparency in the regulatory process by requiring Congress to approve all new major regulations.

Section 3. Revises provisions relating to congressional review of agency promulgating a rule to publish information about the rule in the Federal register and include in its report to Congress and to the Government Accountability Office (GAC) a classification of the rule as a major or nonmajor rule and a complete copy of the cost-benefits analysis of the rule including an analysis of any jobs added or lost, differentiating between public and private sector jobs, sets forth the congressional disapproval procedure for the nonmajor rule, prohibits an agency from allowing a major rule to take effect without the congressional review procedures set forth in this act.

Section B. This bill shall take full force and effect upon the signing of the Governor of Missouri Boys State
