AN ACT

AN ACT TO ESTABLISH AN OFFICIAL CURFEW

Section A. Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Missouri Boys State, as follows:

Section 1. An official curfew shall be established at 11:00 P.M. City Meetings shall be concluded no later than 10:30 P.M. This shall grant citizens an opportunity to socialize amongst themselves. Persons are permitted to retire to their assigned rooms following the City Meeting. Those who choose to stay up must stay in their city meeting area to converse. Citizens that choose to stay in the city meeting area following the City Meeting must maintain a quiet tone of voice in respect to those who do wish to retire following the meeting.

Section 2. (2.1) The City Councilor will announce at 11:00 P.M. it is time for all citizens to return their rooms and for lights to be turned off. Citizens may stay awake as long as they please as long as they are in their assigned rooms with all lights out. (2.2) Any further work that requires light must be completed in the restroom where lights after 11:00 P.M. are permitted.

Section 3. Failure to comply with Section 2 Subsection 2.1 will result in a ticket with a member of the Police Department issuing a court date. Failure to comply with Section 2 Subsection 2.2 will result in a member of the Police Department issuing one warning with the second offense resulting in the same punishment as failure to comply with Section 2 Subsection 2.1. Loud voices such as yelling will not be permitted and will result in a member of the Police Department sending you to your assigned room.

Section B. This legislation will take effect on the twenty-fifth day of June, 2016 at 12:00 P.M. No statute covers scheduling, therefore the passing of this bill would create a scheduling statute. This statute will establish Title VI of the MBS Statutes and will be filed as Official Scheduling.
