AN ACT

AN ACT IN RELATION TO TAXATION WITHOUT APPROPRIATE REPRESENTATION

Section A. Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Missouri Boys State, as follows:

Section 1. No taxes shall be levied against any MBS citizen before their elected officials take office. Therefore, city taxes shall not be collected until said taxes have been approved by the newly elected city council. County taxes shall not be collected until said taxes have been approved by the newly elected county commission. Whereas, state taxes shall not be collected without approval by both the House of Representatives and the Senate.

Section B. This bill shall take full force and effect upon the signing of the Governor of Missouri Boys State
