AN ACT

To Limit the Representation of the Highway Patrol Relating to their Representation in Cities

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Missouri Boys State, as follows:

Section 1. Due to recent circumstances in a city of Missouri Boys' State, it has become apparent that the highway patrol has already abused their privilege of power and needs to have their representation in each city lessened. Under Missouri Boys State Statutes, Title II: General Conduct of Citizens, Statute 206 will be added to institute a "Fair Law Representation in Cities" policy.

Section 2. The highway patrol shall not be allowed any more than 2 officers in any city at any time. If the mayor of a city declares a time of emergency, more highway patrol officers can be allowed inside a city.

Section 3. The Mayor and the Mayor alone will determine if more than 2 highway patrol are needed in his city. If more highway patrol are needed, the mayor will determine how many officers are needed.

Section 4. This bill does not diminish the power of the highway patrol in any way, it only lessens the representation of the highway patrol inside any city.

Floor Amendment - Section 5. If there is found to be more than 2 highway patrol in any city, they will have no jurisdiction until one leaves.

Section B. *This bill shall take full force and effect upon the signing of the Governor of Missouri Boys State*
