AN ACT

To immediately stop prices of the food monopoly which is infringement of Article 2 section 19

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Missouri Boys State, as follows:

Section 1. This bill, would immediately stop the implementation of food prices of the 3 meals which boys state citizens are provided per day.

Section 2. As boys state citizens, we were sponsored by organizations (\$400 USD) to pay for the food and board while attending Missouri Boys State.

Section 3. This implication of \$100 MSB per day would immediately put more than half of the Missouri boys state citizens into debt

Section 4. The ownership of the cafeteria should be illegal and whoever bought the cafeteria should be refunded of all MSB that was paid to purchase the cafeteria.

Section 5. This currently is an emergency that every Missouri state boys are facing and should immediately be passed.

Section 6. Without this bill, all Missouri boys state citizens could potentially starve, with this potential \$300,000 (MSB) business. The purchase of the cafeteria and charging \$100(MSB) per day is considered as a monopoly. This is infringement of Article 2 Section 19 of the Missouri Boys State Constitution by denying citizens to fundamental principals of civil government which is absolutely necessary to preserve the blessings of liberty.
