AN ACT

TO AMEND STATUTE 104.10 TO ALLOW IDENTIFICATION BADGES TO BE REMOVED AT
SPECIFIC TIMES

Section A. Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Missouri Boys State, as follows:

Section 1. 104.10 All city counselors, athletic counselors, all members of the staff, and citizens of MBS shall be required while present upon the location of said MBS, to wear badges of identification. These badges shall state the name and the position of the wearer, and must be worn at all times in plain sight,* (except when citizens are in the privacy of their own rooms or competing in official MBS sanctioned athletic competitions)

(*this bill adds the new language in parenthesis)

Section B. This bill shall take full force and effect upon the signing of the Governor of Missouri Boys State
