AN ACT FOR ANIMAL PERMIT ACT

Section A. Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Missouri Boys State, as follows:

Section 1. All cities and their citizens must have a permit to have any animals living in the city.

Section 2. The animals that will need to be covered in the permit may be of the living or nonliving type, including those made of plastic, paper, fur, etc....

Section 3. The fee for each animal is \$100 for small animals under 6" tall, \$200 for animals under 12", \$450 for animals over 12" tall.

Section 4. All fees must be paid to the State Health Department, the Commissioner will give one quarter of the fee back to the city, and three-fourths of the money from the fee shall go towards the betterment of the state.

Section B. This bill shall take full force and effect upon the signing of the Governor of Missouri Boys State
