**A RESOLUTION**  
TO FREE JIMMY

---

*Be it resolved by the House of Representatives, the Senate concurring therein:*

That at the next general election held at Missouri Boys State, or at a special election called by the governor for that purpose, there is hereby submitted to the qualified voters of this state, for the adoption or rejection, the following \* (example: *amendment to Article VIII*) of the Constitution of Missouri Boys State.

Section A.

Whereas, under Article V, Section 12 of the Missouri Boys State Constitution, “The Governor shall have power to grant...pardons...for all offenses...”

Whereas, the citizens at Missouri Boys State firmly desire for the governor to exercise this power by pardoning the charges against Jimmy Chen for his actions at the Nationalist Party Convention.

Whereas, the massive movement of the “#freejimmy” and its support have made it clear that people see his charges as unjust and ultimately wrong.

Thus, be it resolved, that the Congress here assembled, urge the Governor to exercise his power to pardon in order to “#freejimmy”!
