A RESOLUTION
THE PROHIBITION OF ELECTIONEERING IN REGARDS TO THE POLLING CENTER

Be it resolved by the House of Representatives, the Senate concurring therein:

That at the next general election held at Missouri Boys State, or at a special election called by the governor for that purpose, there is hereby submitted to the qualified voters of this state, for the adoption or rejection, the following amendment of the Constitution of Missouri Boys State.

Section A.

302. The prohibition of electioneering in regards to the polling center.

302.10. No Boys State citizen shall be permitted to electioneer, for himself or another candidate, in the line at the Boys State polling center.

302.20. No Boys State citizen shall be permitted to electioneer 50ft from the end of the voting line.

302.30. A candidate found guilty of breaking this statute will be disqualified from holding office that said candidate was campaigning for.

302.40. A citizen found guilty of breaking this statute will be required to a fine of up to 500BSB
