AN ACT

SB 04 - TO REDUCE THE PREVALENCE AND OCCURRENCE OF ACTIVITIES RELATING TO ORGANIZED CRIME.

Section A. Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Missouri Boys State, as follows:

Section 1. Henceforth this act shall be referred to by the above title or by the following title, “The Godfather Act”

Section 2. Hereafter, an organized crime group shall be defined as two or more citizens of Missouri Boy’s State engaged on conspiring to engage in one or more illicit activities in order to advance money, power, or influence.

Section 3. Any individual convicted of a State crime, and proven beyond a reasonable doubt to be afflicted with an organized crime group, shall be fined no less than 500 BSB no more than 1000 BSB in addition to the sentence levied for the crime itself, **if** the convicted individual is unable to pay the added “Godfather Act” fine, the individual shall be sentenced to one **session** of the governmental activity of policing.

Section 4. If an individual affiliated with an organized crime group is convicted of a crime, all individuals affiliated with said crime group may be tried as if they committed the crime themselves.

Section 5. All funds received from the Godfather fine shall go to the Missouri Boys’ State general fund.

Section B. This bill shall take full force and effect upon signing by the Governor of Missouri Boys State.
