AN ACT

TO PERMIT THE USE OF TECHNOLOGY AT MBS RELATING TO EDUCATIONAL POLICY

Section A. Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Missouri Boys State, as follows:

Section 1. For the purpose of this bill, the use of all forms of technology may be permitted on the condition that they are used for MBS related activities.

Section 2. The recent encouragement of phone use hath paved way for further technological reforms.

Section 3. Many MBS citizens have testified to wanting to use their laptops on the premise of efficiency, but were discouraged to on the MBS website.

Section 4. The MBS website shall remove “Computers/Laptops” from the “What Not to Pack” list and may add “Computers/Laptops” on the “What to Pack” list.

Section 5. MBS is not responsible for the loss of any technology during the MBS week.

Section 6. Misuse (social media, games, horseplay not related to MBS) may result in the confiscation of technology by an MBS Staff member.

Section 7. Confiscated technology shall be returned to its respective use on departure day.

Section 8. This bill shall be referred to as the “Tech Bill”.

Section B. This bill shall take full force and effect upon signing by the Governor of Missouri Boys State.
