AN ACT

TO ESTABLISH A SECTION 116 RELATING TO THE GENERAL OUTLET STORE

Section A. Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Missouri Boys State, as follows:

Section 1. The establishment of Two Governmental Surplus Outlets (G.S.O.'s).

Section 2. 116.1 Governmental surplus outlets are required to sell paper, posters, markers, and other miscellaneous items that are necessary for campaigning, city beautification, and the running of businesses. These G.S.O.'s are required to sell items in exchange for boys state bucks.

Section 3. 116.2 Two governmental surplus outlets must be appointed by the Governor on the third day of Missouri Boys State; however, applications will be accepted on the second day. The two winning cities will both have a G.S.O.

Section 4. 116.3 Henceforth, the two G.S.O.'s are hereby established to encourage either healthy competitions or business partnerships between the two cities of Missouri Boys State.

Section B. This bill shall take full force and effect upon signing by the Governor of Missouri Boys State.
