AN ACT

To add the game of dodgeball relating to the athletic opportunities at MBS

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Missouri Boys State, as follows:

Section 1. The official title of this bill shall be "The Dodgeball Bill"

Section 2. This game would take the place of horse shoes.

Section 3. The Rules: Two teams shall face each other on opposite sides of a court divided by a center line that cannot be crossed by players at any point. Upon this center line shall lie foam dodge balls - evenly spaced. Each player shall start the game along the back wall / line, equidistant apart from the center line as the opposing team's players. Once the game begins, players who are hit with a dodgeball are out and must sit along a side wall / line. Players who have been knocked out may return to the court if a member of their same team, who has not been knocked out, catches an opposing players ball. A player is not out if the throw, made by an opposing player, results in a head shot. The game is over once all players of one team have been eliminated.

Section 4. Official numbers on matters regarding how many players are on a team and how many dodgeballs shall be present will be left up to the description of MBS Senior Councilor of Athletics.
