AN ACT

To Repeal the Position of Gaming Commissioner

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Missouri Boys State, as follows:

Section 1: To rename statute 114 as follows: “Gaming Policies and Regulations”

Section 2: To repeal statute 114.5.

Section 3: To replace statute 114.1 in lieu of: “Any gaming or casino organization must follow normal licensing procedure for businesses and are subject to any taxes and regulations applicable to any other business.”

Section 4: To replace 114.2 in lieu of: “the counties shall have the power to tax, regulate, or ban said gaming businesses as seen fit.

Section 5: To replace 114.3 in lieu of: “Licensed casinos must pay an additional two to five percent tax on profits of the state.”

Section 6: To replace 114.4 in lieu of: “Any gaming or gambling at Missouri Boys State must use Boys State Bucks and no other currency, foreign or domestic.”

Section 7: Any goals and services provided at MBS, with the exception of the American Legion Store, shall be subjected to a sales tax of 25% of the value of the goods sold and services offered.

Section 8: This sales tax shall be collected by the vendor of this aforementioned goods and services from the purchasers.

Section 9: Licensed businesses and vendors must turn in collected taxes at the end of each day along with any other dues or taxes due from that business.

Section 10: This sales tax shall be made usable to the Missouri Boys State General Assembly to be budgeted as seen fit.

Section 11: The sales taxes mentioned in sections two through ten shall not apply to any business

providing statewide postal and delivery services between cities.
