AN ACT

To Amend Punishments and Create Bail Relating to Punishments for Bails and Crime

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Missouri Boys State, as follows:

Section 1. Any citizens convicted of violating any of the provisions of this Act shall be punished by a sentence not to exceed one hour of [policing the grounds] jail time by law enforcement.

Section 2. Any citizens sent to jail under the provision of this Act shall be given the option to post a bail not to exceed \$100 Boys State bucks, which shall go to the city, county, or state that made the arrest.

Section 3. Any citizen of Boys State who shall violate the Provisions of Section 202.40 hereof shall be tried in the Circuit Court of any circuit within the State and if convicted shall be punished by a sentence to [policing of the premises of Boys State] jail time for a period of not to exceed one hour. Any citizen convicted may instead post a bail not to exceed \$200 Boys State Bucks to the state.

Section 4. Any citizen of Boys State found guilty of violating the provisions of Title II, Chapter 203.10, may be dismissed from Boys State at the discretion of the officers and directors of Boys State, or punished by a sentence to [policing of the premises of Boys State] jail time for a period not to exceed one hour.

Section 5. Any person or persons violating the provisions of this Act shall be punished by a sentence to [policing the grounds] jail time for not more than one hour or may post a bail not to exceed \$50 Boys State Bucks.
