



American Legion Boys State of Missouri
 Addendum to the 2021 Citizen Handbook

This packet includes a copy of the 2021 Citizen Handbook, which introduces the Missouri Boys State program, its governmental and political structures, and what citizens can do during the week. Chapter 4 describes governmental and political positions available to citizens of Missouri Boys State. The COVID-19 pandemic has required Missouri Boys State to make several alterations to the program, including which positions citizens are able to hold during the 2021 session. As a result, some positions in Chapter 4 either have been reduced in size or will not be available.

The table below highlights governmental and political positions at each level—ward, city, county, and state—along with positions that are neither governmental nor political that will be available during the 2021 session. As our staff continues to plan, we may add or remove other positions depending on citizen interest and staff member availability.

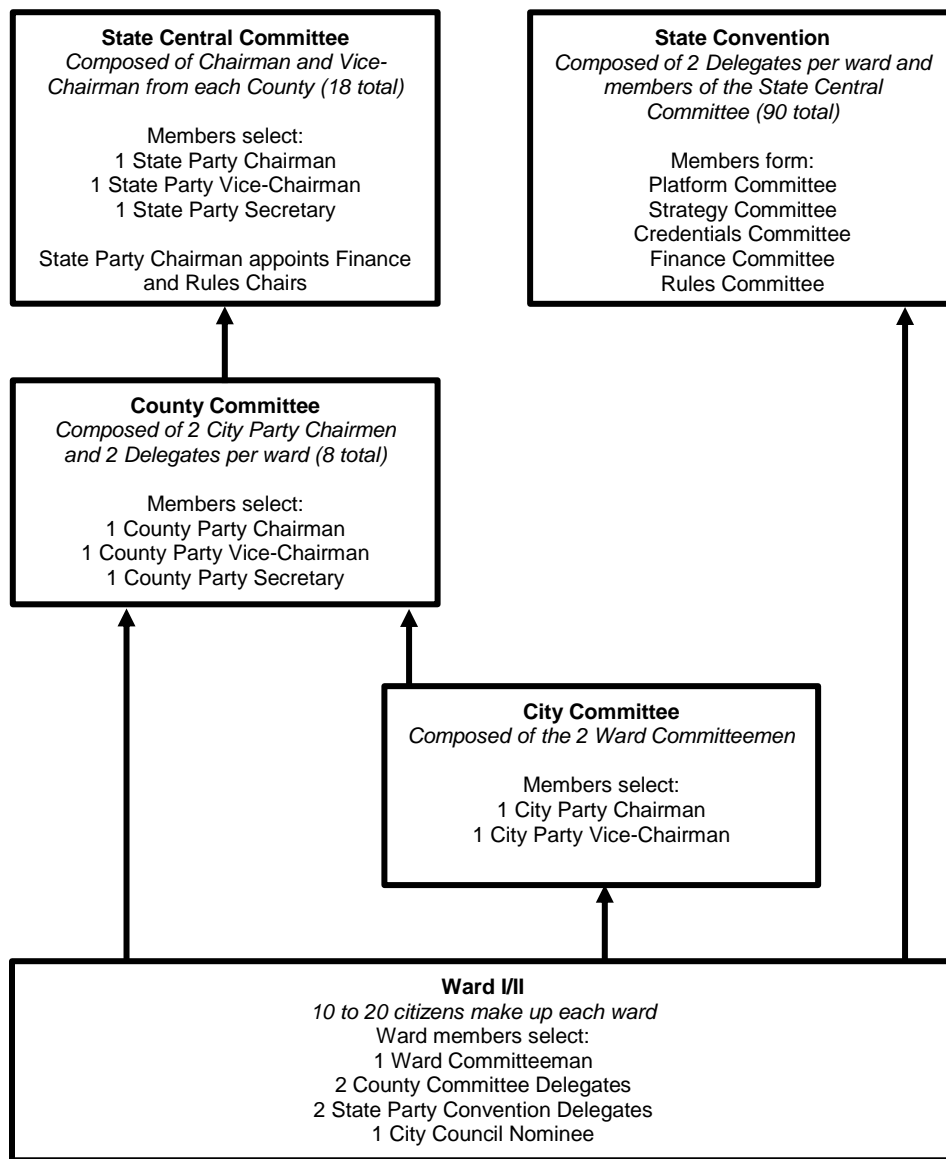
For the 2021 session, Missouri Boys State will add 2 cities (Emerson and Cleaver) and 1 county (Danforth) for a total of 18 cities and 9 counties. Each city is anticipated to have 25 to 35 citizens. As a result of these changes, the program has added 1 judicial district and altered the political party structure.
