AN ACT

TO BAN CAMPAIGNING NEAR POLLING PLACES

Section A. Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Missouri Boys State, as follows:

Section 1. This bill shall be known by its title as listed above or as the "Equal Electioneering Act."

Section 2. The following text will be added to Title III at the MBS statutes:

 "301.70. No citizen may campaign within 20 feet of a polling location.

 301.75. No citizen may bring campaign material within 20 feet at a polling location."

Section 3. Any citizen found in violation of MBS Statute 301.70 will be fined 100BSB. If any citizen is found guilty of violating MBS Statute 301.70 while appearing on the ballot during the time in which the violation occurred, that candidate will be disqualified from the election for the office they were candidate for.

Section 4. Any citizen found in violation of MBS Statute 301.75 will be fined 25BSB.

Section B. This bill shall take full force and effect upon the signing of the Governor of Missouri Boys State
