AN ACT

To Prevent Unreasonably High City Taxes

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Missouri Boys State, as follows:

Section 1: No city official or city council shall institute a flat, percentage tax based on income, above 10% (10 percent). Neither shall a city official or city council institute a universal tax on all citizens of the city, be it a head tax or a property tax, over the amount of 20 BSB (Boys State Bucks) per day. In extension, no city official or city council shall institute both a flat percentage tax and a universal property of head tax. However, the city may enact a one time universal head tax of up to 200 BSB.
