AN ACT

To Create Regulations on Toll Tax for Cities Involving the GSO

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Missouri Boys State, as follows:

Section 1. This bill shall be called “The Right to Campaign Act.”

Section 2. No city or county at MBS shall mandate a toll tax that exceeds \$10 per person entering their city.

Section 3. If the city has the GSO then they may charge a toll tax which only regards to using the GSO for campaigning, which shall not exceed a toll of \$25.

Section 4. The \$25 GSO toll tax shall be a one time tax, and whoever is campaigning shall not be charged for entering the GSO again.

Section 5. If a person is entering the city for reasons other than buying campaigning supplies at the GSO they may be charged for every time they enter the city, but each time they’re charged it shall not exceed \$10.
