AN ACT

To Discourage Bribes

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Missouri Boys State, as follows:

Section 1. No officer of the laws, at the city, county, or state level shall accept gifts, money, and/or other type of compensation in the form of a bribe in an attempt to undermine the law.

Section 2. Officers caught accepting a bribe to overlook a misdemeanor offense shall pay a fine of 50 Missouri Boys State bucks, in addition to the amount of bribe, to the city, county or state corresponding to the jurisdiction of the officer.

Section 3. Officers caught accepting a bribe to overlook a felony offense shall pay a fine of 100 Missouri Boys State bucks, in addition to the amount of the bribe, to the city, county, or state corresponding to the jurisdiction of the officer. Officers caught accepting a bribe to overthrow a felony offense may also be sentenced to up to an hour of jail or community service time.

AN ACT

To Discourage Bribes

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Missouri Boys State, as follows:

Section 1. No law Enforcement at the city, county, or state level shall accept gifts, money, and/or any other type of compensation in the form of a bribe in an attempt to undermine the law.

Section 2. Law enforcement caught accepting a bribe to overlook a misdemeanor offense shall pay a fine of 50 Missouri Boys State bucks, in addition to the amount of bribe to the city, county or state corresponding to the jurisdiction of the officer.

Section 3. Law enforcement caught accepting a bribe to overlook a felony offense shall pay a fine of 100 Missouri Boys State bucks, in addition to the amount of the bribe to the city, county, or state corresponding to the jurisdiction of the law enforcement. Law enforcement caught accepting a bribe to overthrow a felony offense may also be sentenced to up to an hour of jail or community service time.

Section 4. This bill will go into effect directly after the general assembly passes it.

Section 5. Lobbyists must report all gifts to the Secretary of the Senate.
